The technological solution

Development of new practices for the agroecological management of farms with coffee and livestock through agroforestry systems to improve the productive functions and conservation of natural resources.



Description

Technological options were generated to improve economic, social and environmental indicators in farms with integration of coffee and livestock, as well as to strengthen local capacities for planning systems and their articulation to markets.



Results

- Agro-Silvo-Pastoral Systems (SASP) models were designed.
- SASP based on the demands of the chains were established.
- Field schools were established for the training of producers.
- Factors that contribute or restrict the massification of SASP were identified.



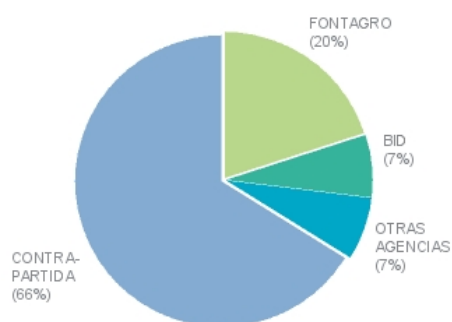

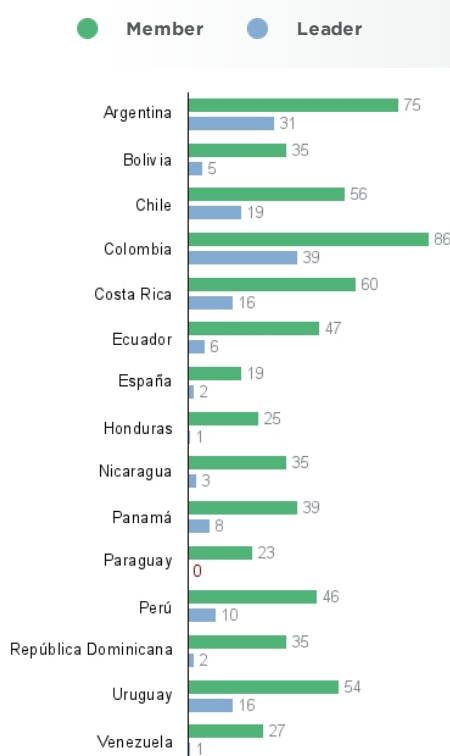
